When: Monday-Friday, June 19th-23th

Who: Boys and Girls going into 1st grade through 6th grade

Where: Winter Park in Danville

Time: 9-11am

Cost: \$30 per child (\$25 if registered before June 6th), cost includes a camp T-shirt (size only guaranteed if registered by June 5th).

What to expect: Campers will learn soccer skills in a fun and engaging atmosphere. No previous soccer experience is required but advanced athletes are welcome as well. Athletes will be placed in age appropriate and skill level groups to ensure everyone learns at the appropriate level.

What to bring: A soccer ball, water, comfortable athletic shoes (either soccer cleats or gym shoes) and shin guards.

She is a veteran of coaching soccer camps and spent two summers in college running soccer camps throughout the Midwest.

Megan March: Is a veteran high school coach with a total of 10 years of experience working with Varsity and JV girls' soccer teams. She played sweeper and forward at Oak Forest High School in the Chicago suburbs and has experience as a soccer referee. She is currently a math teacher at Danville High School.
