Family Tip: Math is Everywhere

Children love collections.

- Encourage children to gather items, especially at the park, beach, forest, or even in the backyard. Ask children to sort their items by size, color, shape, or texture.
- Scavenger hunts are fun! Ask your child to find specific numbers of leaves, rocks, sticks, etc.

Going to the laundry mat?

- Have your child sort clothing by colors.
- Ask your child to estimate the number of loads of laundry
- Ask your child to count the coins and estimate the cost of doing the laundry.
